

Eco insulation

Cape Town-based company Eco-Insulation recently scooped the SA Association for Energy Efficiency's 2008 Company of the Year Excellence Award. Founded by Cecil Homan, the company accepts old newspapers from recyclers and various waste streams and converts them, via a low energy milling process, into a dry pulp resembling cotton wool. The pulp is then treated with an environmentally friendly fire retardant and can be safely pumped into the roof. The 75 to 140mm insulation keeps heat in during winter and out during the summer months. The product is 100 per cent safe and is SABS approved.
